

Team Glow Membership/Participation Terms and Conditions 25/05/2017

The Team Glow membership/ participation terms and conditions apply to paying members (Full Members) and non-paying temporary members (Guests) referred to as "participants".

- Paid membership is a 12 month subscription renewable on the 1st October each year.
- Applicants joining in the month September prior to the October renewal date will be granted membership for the following year inclusive. The membership of anyone joining earlier than 1st September will be considered as expired unless otherwise indicated by the Steering Committee.
- When membership expires, notification is via email. Renewal is due within 28 days. After this period details may be removed from the club management tool and the Team Glow events management tool (Meet Up).
- Guests who have attended more than three Team Glow events but not become a full member within 28 days of the 1st October may be removed from the club management tool and the Team Glow events management tool (Meet Up).
- Guests who have not attended events or visited the site in the months prior to the renewal date may be removed from the Team Glow events management tool (Meet Up).
- All paid members are granted full status membership on the Team Glow events management tool (Meet Up) e.g. "2017 member".
- Temporary members will be known as "Guests" on the Team Glow events management tool (Meet Up).
- All new membership and renewals must be applied for via the British Cycling Management Tool.
- All members' details will be held on British Cycling Management Tool.
- British Cycling / Team Glow will not share personal details with 3rd parties.
- All new subscriptions will be either accepted or rejected by the club secretary. Any person whose application to join the club is rejected have right to appeal in writing to club chair and club secretary.
- Participants are advised to take out their own third party accident cover – this is available via Cycling UK or British Cycling. The Team Glow insurance offers third party cover to ride leaders in their role as a leader. It does not offer individual cover for participation.
- Participants agree to abide by the club constitution which can be found on the club website www.teamglow.net
- Participants are advised to dress appropriately and to take consideration of any likely adverse weather e.g. ice/snow/fog etc and wear appropriate clothing and ride accordingly.
- Participants are advised to wear a helmet.
- Participants are advised to enter their ICE (In Case of Emergency) contact on the BC database when joining Team Glow and to carry ICE details with them on ride.
- The status of ride leader does not in any way indicate responsibility for the individual health, welfare and safety of individual riders.
- By participating in Team Glow events, participants are agreeing to their ability and fitness to take part and that their cycle is in a safe, legal and rideable condition.
- Participants should exercise caution in relation to hazards as perceived by themselves or other members. Rides take place on public roads and Team Glow can not control what happens.
- All rides are undertaken at the participants own risk.
- The ride leader has the right to refuse any rider, whom she may judge unfit or under equipped to participate.
- Membership fees are non-refundable.
- Attending a ride indicates that the participants are fully conversant with the above terms and conditions of membership and participation.
- Tours and holidays hosted by Team Glow are not considered to be led rides and no liability is accepted by Team Glow.
